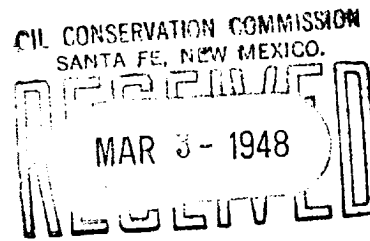

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Went into old well and drilled out about 40 feet of lead wool and steel cuttings, then cleaned out the well to total depth of 2821'. Possibly made some new hole as old records show T.D. of 2782', the well being drilled to that depth in 1926. We are not sure that any new hole was made. Cemented string of 7" at 2187' by squeezing, then acidized between 2780 and 2821' with 1500 gallons Dowell X. The above work resulted in well easily making 40 barrels daily.
