On September 26, 1948 we ran 2650' of 7" O.P., 2 1/2 b. seamless, second-hand and cemented with 100 sacks of cement, using Halliburton equipment. This pipe was set on a plastic bridge placed by Powell Chemical Company. We intend to drill the plug, clean out the bottom, and test for ~~skullin~~ shut off starting at 4:00 P.M. on September 29, 1948.

Note: The 8" casing was left cemented in the hole. We had originally intended to pull it.
