FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

To drill out all existing bridges and test. Then to deepen well to approximately 6500' or commercial production at a lesser depth if encountered, in the opinion of the Operator. In the event we receive commercial production at the deepest depth, as proposed, it is our intentions to run 3" seamless tubing if water is encountered and cement same back to 4000'. After cementing we will run a temperature survey to be positive. If no water is encountered, we will run squeeze jobs on each and every perforation in the existing 4 1/2" casing, which is now cemented from top to bottom, and free well in the prospective producing zone. In the event no production is encountered in this well at a depth of 6500', we will plug back to 4000' and attempt to complete well in the now existing perf. zone.
