### NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Kaseman Well  
No. 4 in SE NW SW of Sec. 4 Twp. 18 S., Rge. 28 E.,  
N. M. P. M., Artesia Oil Field, Eddy County.  
We plan to commence work on Immediately, 1933.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

**Pulled 6-5/8" pipe to try to increase production, which was unsuccessful.  
The well would only make 1/2 barrel per day prior to pulling pipe.**

The present condition of the well is as follows:

**Total depth 2300' with the following pipe in the hole.**

**2050' of 6-5/8"  
395' of 10".**

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

**Fill hole with mud laden fluid to first lime above the pay sand, then will put in five sacks of cement with dump bottom bailer. Will then fill hole with mud laden fluid up to the bottom of the 10" and then pull the 10" and fill with mud to 250' and pull pipe on up and put in three sacks of cement to shut off water. Will then fill hole to surface and set piece of pipe for a marker.**
