Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public, but such operations should be witnessed by an Oil and Gas Inspector if possible.

### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Filled the hole with mud laden fluid to 1550' and filled in with five feet of loose rock and set five sacks of cement. Then filled hole with mud laden fluid to 135' and put in five feet of loose rock and set three sacks of cement and then filled hole to surface with mud laden fluid and set a piece of three inch pipe for a marker. We pulled the following pipe as we were plugging the well.
