Gentlemen:

On November 19, 1959, a survey was made to locate your No. 1 Well on the State "BC" lease at a point 650.3 feet from the West line and 663.5 feet from the North line of Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

A flag was set at the USGLO Quarter corner marker common to Sections 33 and 4, and the Transit was set up at the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 32, 33, 4 and 5. Thence chaining N88°55'E a distance of 650.3 feet to a point on the North line of Section 4, thence S0°24'W a distance of 663.5 feet to the location site of the State "BC" No. 1. As a check on our survey we chained S88°55'W from the location site a distance of 650.3 feet, thence N0°24'E 663.5 feet to the point of beginning of our survey, checking in within the allowable error for this survey.

On November 20, 1959, we were informed that the location site had been moved 100 feet West to an offset stake that we had set on the survey. The location site will now be 550.3 feet from the West and 663.5 feet from the North line of Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

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
