Spudded 11" hole on 11-22-59. On 11-23-59, 8-5/8" O.D. 22.7# new casing was run and set at 980' (TD) and cemented with 500 sz. cement, circulated. After WOG 24 hours, tested casing with 450 psi for 30 minutes with no loss in pressure. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" and resumed drilling operations.
