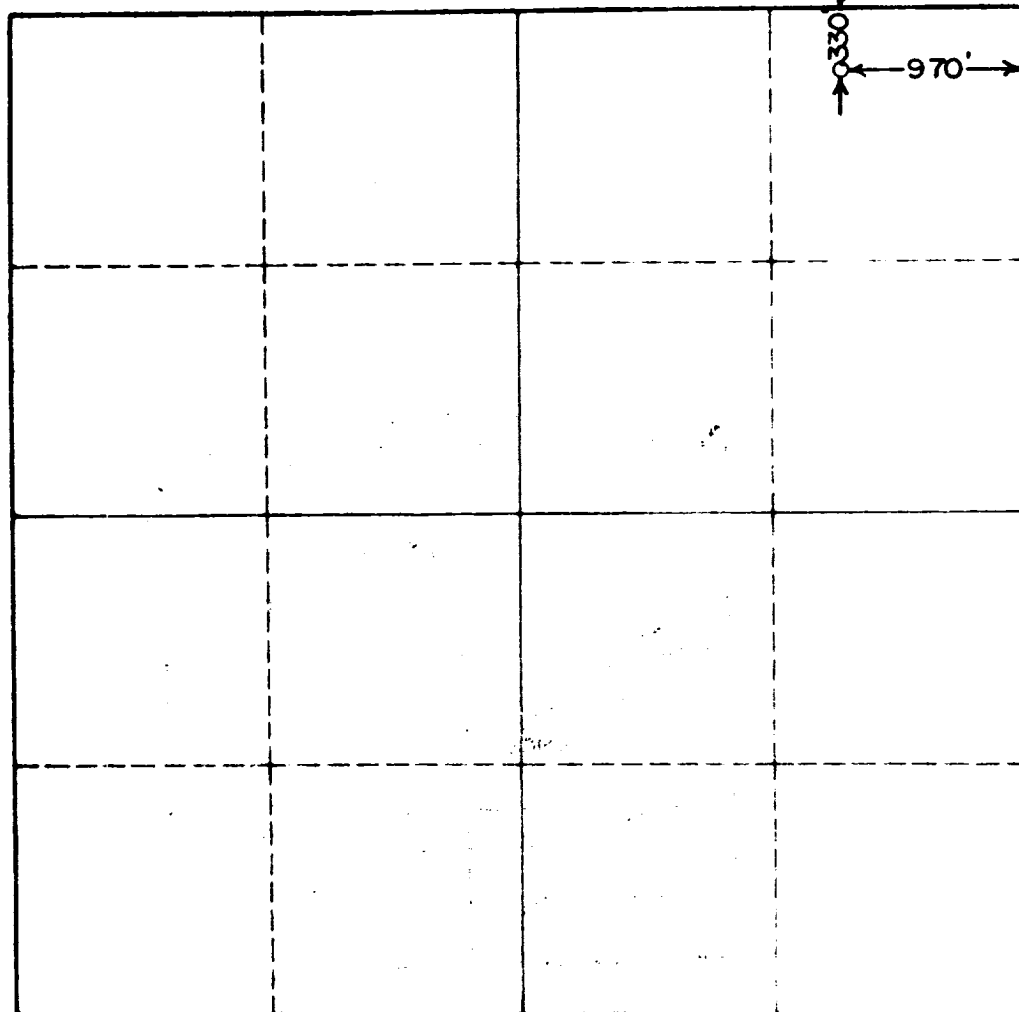


Gentlemen:

On January 26, 1960, a survey was made to relocate your No. 1 location on the State "BH" Lease at a point 970 feet from the East Line and 330 feet from the North Line of Section 5, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico.

A flag was set at the U.S.G.L.O. Quarter Corner marker common to Sections 32 and 5, and the Transit was set up at the U.S.G.L.O. Section Corner marker common to Sections 32.33.5 & 4. Thence chaining $S88^{\circ}55'W$ from the Transit a distance of 970 feet, Thence $SO^{\circ}24'W$ 330 feet to the location site of the State "BH" No. 1. As a check on our survey we chained $N88^{\circ}55'E$ 970 feet from the location site to a point on the East Boundary Line of Section 5. Thence $NO^{\circ}24'E$ 330 feet to the point of beginning of our survey, checking in within the allowable error for this survey.
