9-25-2002 - Rigged up pulling unit. POOH with rods and pump. Nippled down wellhead and nipped up BOP. Rigged up floor and tubing equipment. POOH with 2-7/8" tubing. Rigged up wireline. RIH with gauge ring to 2600'. POOH. RIH with CIBP and set CIBP at 2600'. POOH with wireline. Dumped 35' of cement on top of CIBP. POOH with wireline and rigged down wireline. Shut well in for night.
9-26-2002 - RIH with tubing and tagged plug at 2568'. Circulated hole with plugging mud. POOH with tubing. Rigged up wireline. Perforated 7" casing at 1235'. POOH and rigged down wireline. RIH with packer and tubing to 940'. Pressured up to 1500 psi. Could not break down perforations. Shut well in for night.
9-27-2002 - Pressured up to 1500 psi. Rigged up wireline. Re-perforated at 1230'. POOH with wireline and rigged down wireline. Pressured up to 1500 psi. NOTE: BLM approved to spot plug. POOH with packer. RIH open ended to 1284'. Spotted 25 sacks Class C Neat cement. POOH with tubing. WOC 4 hours. RIH with tubing and tagged plug
