PURPOSE: ALLOWABLE REVISION (WATERFLOOD)

Effective 3-1-64, the allowable of the following Newmont Oil Company wells in the pools listed below are hereby revised as indicated:

Ballard A #2,4-J, 1-18-39, increased from 210 to 370 bbls daily or 11470 bbls for the month.
Ballard A #3-E, 1-18-39, increased from 34 to 40 bbls daily or 1240 bbls for the month.
Ballard B #2,7-G, 1-18-39, increased from 90 to 136 bbls daily or 4216 bbls for the month.
Schurich #6-F, 32-17-30, increased from 6 to 15 bbls daily or 465 bbls for the month.
Schurich #5,7-H, 32-17-30, increased from 300 to 370 bbls daily or 11470 bbls for the month.
State "A" #2-O, 36-17-39, increased from 65 to 75 bbls daily or 2325 bbls for the month.
State "A" #51-H, 32-17-30, increased from 90 to 115 bbls daily or 3565 bbls for the month.
Tallmadge #3-B, 32-17-30, increased from 25 to 40 bbls daily or 1240 bbls for the month.
