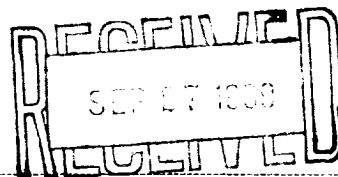

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Shot well with 150 quarts from 2630 feet to 2660 feet--cleaned well out after shot--ran 2607 feet of 2" upset new tubing through Hendeliter Head and connected same up to tanks for production. Pipe (production string) showed no cracks or leaks due to shot--pressure on tubing showed 520 pounds. Well tested 61 barrels in five hours flowing through 1/8th inch choke.
