## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After setting 2534 ft. of 7" O.D. (20 lb. seamless pipe) Casing with 100 sacks of cement and 3 tons of mud, let same set for 72 hours, the hole was bailed dry -- cement plug drilled out and hole bailed dry again. Let hole set for one hour and re-bailed -- result, complete water shut-off. Resumed drilling operations.
