
DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Shot well on Nov. 6, 1939 with 50 qts. of Nitro-glycerin, from 2644' to 2654'. Shot was tamped with 2 yards of gravel and loaded hole with oil.

Cleaned out well to bottom and ran 2750' of 2" tubing. Well did not flow. Made swab test 6 hours, producing 108 bbls. of oil and 35 bbls. of water. Now installing pumping unit.
