Run 2538' of 7" O. D. Casing and cemented with 100 sacks of cement and mudded with 5 tons of mud. We let set for 72 hours before drilling plug, after the 72 hours was up drilled plug and tested for water shut-off; Results, was a complete water shut-off.

Casing was run August 29, 1941, and drilled plug and tested for water shut-off on September 3, 1941.
