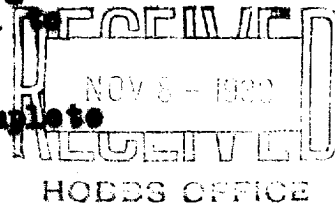

Title
