Shot well on Jan. 9, 1940 with 100 qts. of nitro-glycerin, from 2838 to 2840 ft. Hole was loaded with oil and shot tamped with 1 1/2 yards of gravel.

After shot, cleaned out to bottom and run 2838 ft. of 2" upset tubing.

On test, well made 100 bbls. of oil in 5 hours.
