This well is scheduled to be Plugged & Abandoned pursuant to Mr. John English's conversation with Mr. James Knauf of the U. S. G. S. on 2/17/78. It will be plugged in the following manner due to a 6 1/2" bit being lost in the hole at 1180' in the 7" casing:

1. Set a 7" cement retainer @ 1170' and attempt to establish a pump-in rate below the bridge @ 1180'. If this is successful, we will then pump cement and mud down-hole past the bridge prior to plugging the well from 1180' to the surface. If the 7" casing is collapsed, (as suspected due to the 6 1/2" bit being lodged at this point) then we will proceed with Step #2.
Note: Salt water mud will be placed between all plugs.

2. Pump 10 sx cement plug through cement retainer @ 1170'.
3. Spot a cement plug from 1170' to 1000'.
4. Spot a cement plug from 435' to 335'.
5. Spot a cement plug from 191' to 91'.
6. Spot a cement plug at surface.
7. Erect P & A marker, cut off and remove all well service anchors, fill cellar, remove junk and equipment from location, cover all pits and level location to the original contour of the surface.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
