2-17-78 - Received permission in telephone conversation with Mr. James Knauf to plug this well in the following manner:

- 1. Ran 7" Halliburton cement retainer and set at 1170'; pumped 1100# on tubing, circulated fluid on backside of 7" casing, pressure dropped to vacuum.**
- 2. Halliburton pumped 10 sx Class H cement plug w/4% Cacl below cement retainer @ 1170', pulled clear of cement retainer and from 1168' pumped 34 bbls salt water w/12 sx brine gel & 70 sx Class H cement plug w/4% Cacl. Shut down 2 hours, tagged plug with wire line @ 1001'. With tubing @ 435', pumped 3.5 bbls salt water w/2 sx brine gel & 35 sx Class H cement plug from 435' to 335'. With tubing set @ 191', pumped 5 bbls salt water w/2 sx brine gel & 35 sx Class H cement plug from 191' to 91'. With tubing @ 20', pumped 3 bbls salt water w/1 sx brine gel & 15 sx Class H cement plug. Set plugged hole marker and rigged down pulling unit.**

Instructions
