DETAILS OF WORK

To deepen well from depth of 1654' to a depth of 3200' to test San Andres or encounter oil production in San Andres at a lesser depth. well was making 8 barrels per day.

We propose to run approximately 2915 ft. of 5 1/2" casing with a change over collar at about 2200' to allow recovery of 5" casing above that point after acidizing pay zone anticipated at about 2925.

Well be cemented with 25 sacks of cement at 2915 before drilling into pay.
