DETAILS OF WORK

This well was drilled to 3017 ft. in 1939 and at the time was plugged back to 2635. During re-work efforts this year, the open hole became bridged at 2660 and the hole was junked with wash pipe above this depth. There is 60 feet of tubing and wash pipe in the old shot hole from 2550 to 2630. We plan to plug the well in Oct. of 1952 by placing a cement plug at 2300 feet. After that, we will attempt to recover the 7" casing above 2300 feet and the 8" casing above 300 feet. We would then place cement plugs in the open hole at the base of the salt beds (700'), in the top of the remaining surface pipe and at the ground level point of the well. The existing casing and open hole now would be loaded with water before the pipe is cut the first time.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
