1. Removed P & A marker.
2. Uncovered 8-5/8" surface casing (old records indicated this casing was removed) and screwed into casing and nipped up wellhead.
3. Drilled 8' cement plug at surface.
4. Cleaned out wood and debris to 2100'.
5. Halliburton displaced hole with 9.4#/gal drilling mud (chl = 65,000 ppm, 3% KCL & WL = 8.6 cc).
6. Halliburton pumped 1st. plug consisting of 250 sx Class C w/2/10 of 1% CFR-2 from 2100' back to 1348' (tagged top of plug w/wireline).
7. Halliburton pumped 2nd. plug consisting of 50 sx Class H w/2/10 of 1% CFR-2 (cement was mixed with above DM as mix water) from 850' to 750'.
8. Displaced hole above 750' with Drilling Mud.
9. Halliburton pumped 3rd. plug consisting of 140 sx Class H w/.2 of 1% CFR-2 from 450' back to 350' (this plug was shortened due to presence of 8-5/8" surface csg.)
10. Halliburton pumped 4th. and final cement plug consisting of 10 sx of Class H cement at surface.
11. Re-erected P & A marker, cut off anchors, backfilled and cleaned location.
