Elevation of well 3495 feet

Operations were commenced July 31, 1939

8 1/2", 28 lb casing was set at 321 ft.

1/2 bailer water (practically none) found at 215 ft.

The water shut off was tested by 6 hours shut down and running of bailer which showed dry.

The 7 1/2" (OD new 20 lb pipe) was set at 2318 ft. and water shut off tested as above, showing ~~dry~~ absence of same
