This well has been Temporarily Abandoned since Feb. 1, 1973. From July 10, 1970 until August 15, 1971 this was an active Water Injection Well in our Far West Loco hills Sand Unit Flood No. 58. Due to poor water injection rates, permission was granted to convert to production. Oil production also proved to be very poor.

This area is under study to find a more effective water injection procedure; when this is determined the well will be put back on as an active well within this Unit.
