On about May 21, 1948 plan to shoot well as follows: 2645-2696 with 100 qts solidified in 3 1/2" shell, 2630-2645- 15' of gravel, 2590-2630- 4 sacks (40') calceol.

Then, on about May 22, 1948 plan to again shoot well as follows: 2570-2590 with 40 qts solidified in 3 1/2" shell, 2555-2570- 15' of gravel, 2495-2555- 6 sacks (60') calceol. Hole to be loaded with oil.
