DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On ~~about~~ May 21, 1948 shot well as follows: 2645-2696 with 100 qts solidified in 3 1/2" shell, 2630-2645 15' of gravel, 2590-2630 4 sacks (40') calseal.

Then, on ~~about~~ May 22, 1948 again shot well as follows: 2570-2590 with 40 qts solidified in 3 1/2" shell, 2555-2570 15' of gravel, 2495-2555 6 sacks (60') calseal. Hole was loaded with oil.

Upon cleaning out well swab tested 25 Bbls. of oil per day which is an increase of approximately 24 bbls. per day.
