DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 453' of 8 1/2" 28# casing and cemented with 50 sacks of cement using Gibson Cementing equipment.

On December 24, 1939 after waiting 72 hours for cement to set drilled plug and tested water shut-off with a four hour bailing test and found we had a complete water shut-off.
