Set 2521' of 7" OD seamless 20# casing and cemented with 100 sacks of cement and mudded with 5 tons of mud using Gibson cementing equipment.

After waiting 72 hours for cement to set drilled plug and tested water shut-off with a four hour bailing test and found we had a complete water shut-off.
