DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 488' of 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " 28# casing and cemented with 50 sacks of cement using Halliburton cementing equipment. After waiting 72 hours for cement to set drilled plug and tested shut-off with a four hour bailing test and found we had a complete and satisfactory shut-off.
