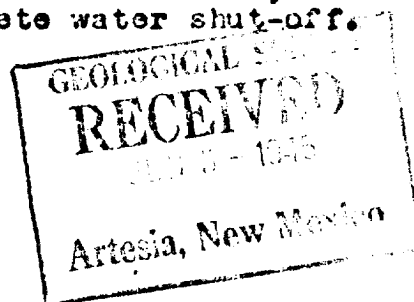

### DETAILS OF WORK

On May 18, 1945, ran 400 feet of 8 1/2" casing and cemented with 50 sacks of cement, using Halliburton Oilwell Cementing Co. method. After standing 72 hours for cement to set, test by bailing on May 21, 1945 showed complete water shut-off.
