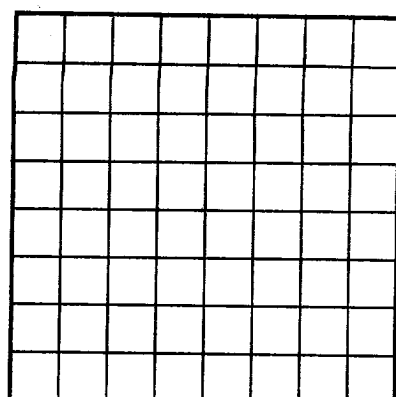

Well was shot December 28th with 100 quarts Nitro-glycerin, 2688 to 2686. Started flowing and produced 500 barrels of oil while cleaning out to bottom. Completed the well January 5 th, 1940. The connection was completed and first oil run January 12 th. On open flow through 2" tubing well flowed 160 barrels of 38 Gravity Oil in five hours. No test has been made for volume of gas. Making no water. Builds up 400 lb. rock pressure when closed in for 12 hours. Coker set on tubing in 6 7/8" casing at 2100 feet.
