Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter of March 12th in which you request an allowable for your Brinson-Woodall Saunders #3, Loco Hills Pool. In this letter you state that you are at a loss to understand why this well is not on the proration schedule since it has been producing right along.

Since it is rather unusual for an operator to report that a well has been producing that does not appear on the proration schedule and therefore is apparently producing without authority, I checked with Mr. Hanson of our Artesia office as to the status of your well file.

Mr. Hanson advises me that no Form C-110, Certificate of Authorization to Transport Oil, nor Form C-104, Request for Allowable, has been filed with his office. Since this well is located on a federal lease, Mr. Hanson checked with the United States Geological Survey in Artesia and was advised that the well was on production between the periods of November, 1948, through July 1951, at which time it was abandoned.

In view of the fact that you say that the well has been producing right along, I am at a loss to understand why you have not reported the production on Form C-115 along with your #1 and #2 wells.

In order for us to assign an allowable to this well, it will be necessary for you to file Form C-104 and C-110 with the Artesia office of the Commission.
