The well was plugged Dec. 27, 1956. A 10 sx cement plug was spotted at 2700'. 7" casing was shot off at 1000' and 971' was recovered. A 20 sx cement plug was placed at 412' (bottom of 8 5/8" surface). A 10 sx cement plug and a 3" marker was placed in the top of the 8 5/8". The marker identifies the location. The location is clear of all junk except for old cement block on which pump unit used to set.

Well I finally ran this thing down. Continental had the well in the P & A file but did not have anything on the plugging.

I discovered that Hobbs Pipe & Supply plugged the well on Dec. 27, 1965.


The records show that they put a 10sx plug at 2700 feet. They shot off the 7" at 1000' and laid down 971 feet.

The 8 5/8" surface was left in the well. They put a 20sx plug in the bottom of the 8 5/8 at 412 feet. They put a 10sx plug and marker in the well at the surface.

I had our pumper check the marker and it is 3" and is well labeled. The location is cleared of junk.

I am submitting Form C-103 on this basis. Thank you for being so patient.
