We propose to plug and abandon this well because of insufficient production. Total depth of this well is 2622'. We propose to part and pull the 7" casing now cemented at 2399' with 100 sacks of cement and pump 25 sacks cement in bottom of hole and fill with mud to top of parted 7" pump in 20 sacks cement, fill with mud to bottom of 8 1/2" pipe set at 415' and cemented with 50 sacks cement, pump in 20 sacks cement, fill with mud to top and set regulation marker in cement.
