DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill a well with rotary tools to a depth of approximately 3050 feet. We intend to set approximately 350 feet of 8-5/8" casing in the top of the salt and cement with 50 ex. cement. If commercial production is encountered, we intend to set 5-1/2" casing to T.O. and cement with 100 ex. cement. All casing will be ~~not~~ cemented by approved methods of U.S.G.S.

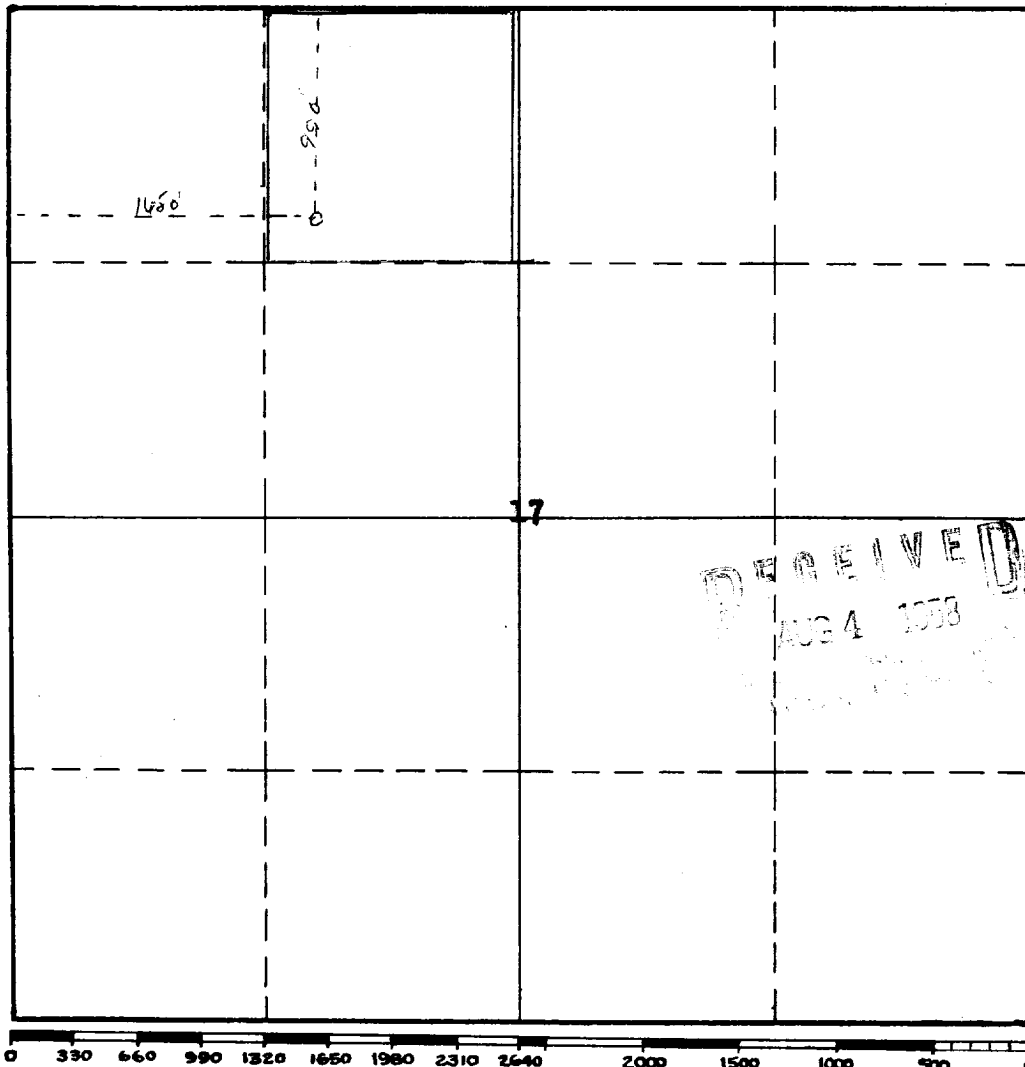
