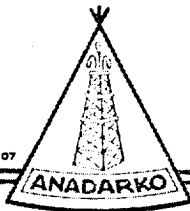

Gentlemen:

New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Form C-104, "Authorization to Transport Oil and Natural Gas," dated September 4, 1973, authorizes Texas-New Mexico Pipe Line to transport crude oil from above referenced well.
