 Placed 225 sks cement from 2550' to 1517', Top of cement 1517'. Filled hole with 10# mud to 390'. Placed 20 sks cement from 390' to 331'. Top of cement 331'. Filled hole with 10# mud to 21'. Placed 10 sks. cement from 21' to surface. Cemented 3" X 6' marker indicating location.
 Covered all oil and mud around well, cleared location of trash. Plugging job completed June 13, 1959.
