- 2) 1700 to 1600' - 30 sacks cement (Limestone - show oil)
- 3) 1000 to 900' - 30 sacks cement (Base Salt @ 942')
- 4) 400 to 300' - 35 sacks cement (Top Salt 355', bottom cas. 365')

Cemented marker pipe at surface according to regulations. All surface equipment has been removed. The location has been cleaned up and pit filled.
