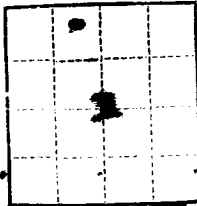

DETAILS OF WORK

To test the Red Sand or Queen Section, at approx. 2400 feet. May drill on to the Grayburg. Will set 8 5/8" casing at approx. 350 feet, and will cement if water is encountered. Will set production pipe on top if oil is encountered in commercial quantities, and will cement as per requirements of U.S.G.S.

If Queen Sand section is dry, we may continue drilling to approximately 3500 feet to test the Grayburg - San Andres Section. We will contact your office before drilling beyond 2400 feet.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
