

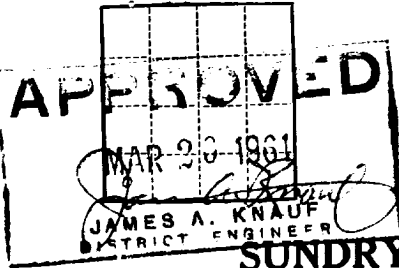

We plan to drill a 2900' San Andres test, using cable tools.

We expect to cement 8 5/8" surface casing in the top of the salt at approximately 400' with 75 sacks.

If production is found, we will run and cement a 5 1/2" oil string.

All casing will be run and cemented using methods approved by the U. S. Geological Survey.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

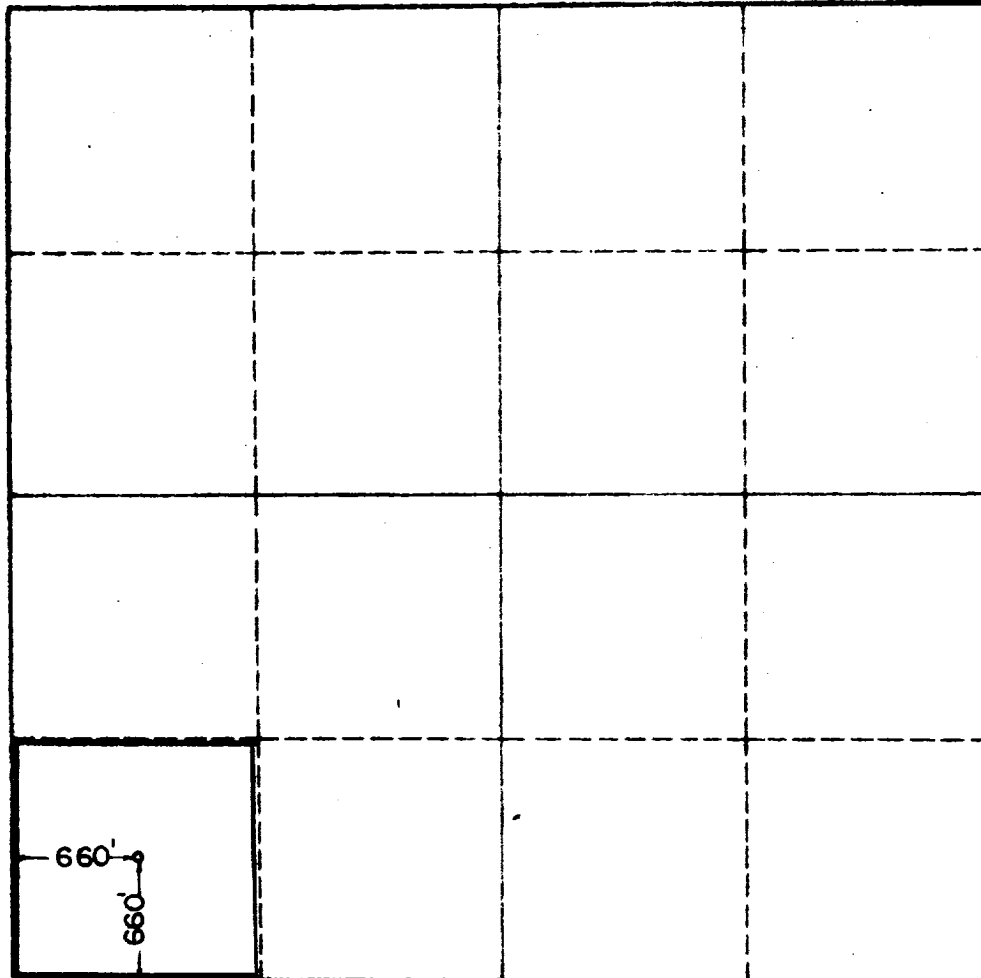
