

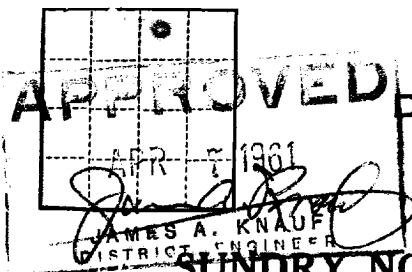

DETAILS OF WORK

Propose to drill with rotary tool to approximately 2100 feet to test the Queen formation. Intend to drill 9" hole and set 7" OD 170 or 200 SN seamless casing at approximately 350 feet, and cement with 50 sac regular cement with 2% gal. Drill 6 1/2" hole total depth and run 4 1/2" OD 9.60 new surface casing on oil string and cement with 100 sac regular cement or enough cement to cover all zones of interest. Intend to abide by the rules and regulations of the department.
