1. 2 P 20 17S 30E 00QS Grayburg Jackson Queen McIntyre A-2 -
in the near future, we plan to move in reverse unit,
wash to bottom, and plug and abandon this well.
2. 2 0 8 18S 30E 00QS Loco Hills Grayburg Masteller 2 -
in the next few weeks, we plan to move in a rotary
rig and deepen this well to test the San Andres.
3. 2 P 27 18S 30E 00QG Benson Queen Grayburg N Federal N -
negotiating to sell for salvage.
4. 11 P 35 13S 29E North King Camp Unit - presently
negotiating to sell production from this well.
5. 2 E 4 18S 30E 00Q Loco Hills Queen Grayburg Nelson 2 -
after receiving approval to plug and abandon, it
was decided that a larger pump might move sufficient
fluid to make this well commercial. We plan to in-
stall a larger pump in the near future.
