a ran 757' 35/8" cas. and cemented with 50 sacks, did not obtain water shutoff. cemented with 50 sacks and obtained water shutoff. We drilled to a total depth of 2510' to lower Yates sand and ran 5 1/2" cas. to 2.0. We perforated from 2454 to 2457 and 2463 to 2470, and sand-oiled treated with 30,000 gal. oil and 30,000 gal. sand. Well was completed for 10 bbls. Cemented 5 1/2" cas. with 100 sacks.
