Well is presently producing from open hole section 3688-3780' in the San Andres Formation.**We propose to perforate and treat as follows:**

1. Move in and rig up Pulling Unit.
2. Pull rods and lower tubing to check for fill-up.
3. Clean well out to total depth.
4. Selectively perforate 5-1/2" OD casing from 3326-3574' with a total of 14 shots.
5. Isolate and treat through 5-1/2" OD casing perforations 3326-3574' with 1000 gallons acid and ball sealers.
6. Isolate and treat through 5-1/2" OD casing perforations 3326-3574' with 20,000 gallons water and 20,000 20/40 sand.
7. Run tubing and pull Retrievable Bridge Plug.
8. Run tubing and rods and return well to a producing status.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
