Well is presently pumping 4 BO + 12 BWPD. It is proposed to stimulate the well as follows: Treat 9th zone below a Lynes packer set at 3855' with 2,000 gallons of HAL-4033 gel + 2,500 gallons of MOD-202 acid containing Protexall. Treat 6th zone between Lynes straddle packers set at 3485' and 3570' with 500 gallons of acid with Protexall + 20,000 gallons of gelled water mixed with 15,000# of 20-40 sand.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
