This well is pumping 29 barrels of oil + 10 barrels of water per day.

We propose to increase these volumes by a fracture treatment in the 7th and 9th zones. It is proposed to run 3½" O.D. tubing and set a Lynes Packer at about 3840'. Open hole below (9th zone) will be treated with 2 stages using 5,000 gallons Redi-frac + 3,500# sand + Gypban L-35 in each stage. A plug consisting of rock salt and moth balls will be spotted between stages. Packer will then be raised to straddle the 7th zone at about 3670' to 3700'. The 7th zone will be treated with 6,000 gallons Redi-frac + 4,000# sand + Gypban L-35.

Instructions
