On Nov. 4, 1968, ran 3½" O.D. N-80 tubing with Lynes straddle packers. Set upper packer at 3802-06 and lower packer at 3832-36. Circulated oil and gas out of casing annulus. Opened tool below packers. Pumped in 60 barrels of water and 200 gallons of acid at 15 BPM at 3900 psi. Had some communication. Reset packers at 3806-10 and 3836-40. Pumped 30 bbls. water into formation 15 BPM at 3700 psi. Still had communication

Reset packers at 3664-68 and 3698-3704'. Pumped in 30 bbls. water at 4100 psi. and 12 BPM. No communication. Fraced 7th Zone with 400 gallons acid plus 6,000 gallons Redi-frac plus 4,000# sand with 100# Gypban L-35. Broke at 3800 psi. at 17 BPM. Treated at 3500 psi. at 17 BPM. (S.D. pressure 2100 psi.) Opened tool below packers. Fraced 9th zone with 6,300 gallons Redi-frac plus 4500# sand plus 100# Gypban L-35. Started at 3900 psi. at 16 BPM. Treated at 3200-4000 psi. at 16 BPM.

On Nov. 25, 1968, well pumped 75 BO plus 111 BWPD.

On Dec. 15, 1968, well pumped 42 BO plus 50 BWPD.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
