It is proposed to plug this well back with a bridge plug set at 3976' with 5' of cement on top. 5 1/2" casing will then be perforated at 3908-14, 3921-22, 3924-25 and 3929-35 with 2 jet shots/ft. Perforations will be acidized with 500 gallons of 20% retarded acid.

Instructions
