On April 15, 1971, a retrievable bridge plug was set at 3918' and RTTS packer set at 3860'. Acidized perforations from 3908-14 with 3,000 gallons of Cal Chek acid containing 27 gallons of Protex (gyp scale inhibitor). Treated at 3½ BPM, increasing to 4 BPM at 3500 psi. On April 27, 1971, well pumped 20 BO + 182 BWPD. On July 6, 1971, well pumped 22 BO ± 145 BWPD. Prior to work, well pumped 10 BO + 71 BWPD.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
