## DETAILS OF WORK

We will set approximately 600 feet of 8-5/8" casing and cement with 30 sacks. We will set approximately 4,000 feet of 3-1/2" casing and cement with 350 sacks. We will drill with cable tools to a depth of approximately 4,000 feet to test the San Andres formation, and complete through perforations. Authority to drill at this unorthodox location was granted by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission by their Order No. R-1693, dated June 10, 1960.


