DETAILS OF WORK

I propose to drill this well with rotary to a depth of approximately 4000 feet as a Grayburg-San Andres test. We will cement 5-5/8" casing at approximately 170' with 200 sacks. 5" casing will be cemented close to bottom with 350 sacks. Completion will be made through perforations. Although the well will be produced for the present, it is anticipated that the well will be used for a water injection well at a later date. This unorthodox location was approved by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission by their Order 4-2035.

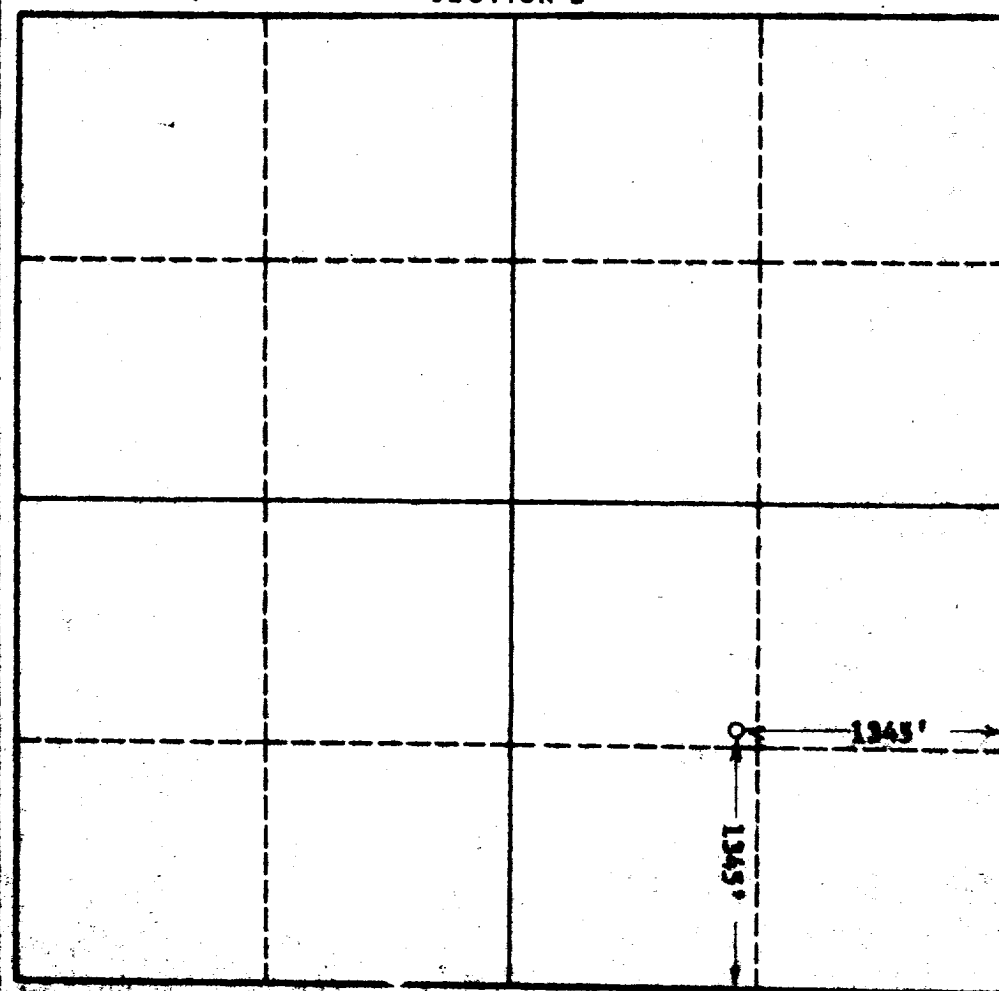
